Know Your Treatment Options for COVID-19

There are more treatment options available now for COVID-19. Treatments can prevent hospitalization and death for at-risk individuals. **Talk to your healthcare provider** about treatment options if you are at-risk of serious illness and interested in a preventative treatment OR if you are at-risk and test positive for COVID-19.

Treatments are not a substitute for vaccination. Vaccination remains the safest, most effective way to protect you from COVID-19. **Treatments must be started early, so don't delay testing**. Here is information on 3 available COVID-19 treatments.
